


INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS

1. The name of the school is: **Alpington and Bergh Apton Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a Voluntary Aided School.
3. The name of the Governing Body is: **The Governing Body of Alpington and Bergh Apton Church of England Primary School**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a) 2 elected parent governors
 - b) 1 LA governor
 - c) 1 elected staff governor
 - d) 1 head teacher
 - e) 1 co-opted governor
 - f) 8 foundation governors
5. Total number of governors: 14
6. One foundation governor shall be appointed by the Bishop of Norwich
Three foundation governors shall be appointed by the Norwich Diocesan Board of Education
Two foundation governors shall be appointed by each Parochial Church Council of Yelverton St Mary with Alpington, and Bergh Apton SS Peter and Paul.
7. A trust exists.
8. School ethos: Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

9. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 1 January 2015
