## Science

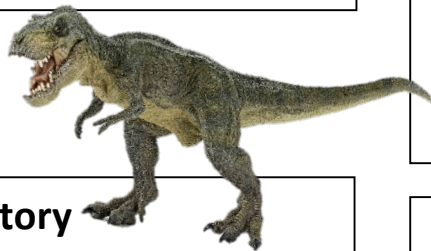
